MINORITY VENDOR FAIR A SUCCESS!



There was excitement in the air on May 25th as 75 minority and woman-owned business leaders showed up at the Attucks Theatre for the latest Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) Vendor Fair, sponsored by the City of Norfolk, Brinshore, Banc of America Community Development Corporation, and BBRM Norfolk Partners, LLC. Participants learned about new construction opportunities for the next phase of redevelopment of the former Tidewater Gardens community, now known as Kindred.

Breeden Construction is the general contractor for the development of multi-family buildings on Blocks 17 and 18. Mark Roy, Business Unit Leader with Breeden, gave an overview of the work to be completed and presented available sub-contracting opportunities. Participants actively engaged in a robust discussion and asked lots of questions. Afterwards, those in attendance had the chance to network with representatives from SWaM, project developers, Section 3, bonding companies and more, while enjoying delicious munchies.
