PEOPLE FIRST BY THE NUMBERS

- There are currently 583 households and 1,546 individuals receiving family support services from People First, USI, with a total of 593 household assessments completed as of July 31st, 2023.
- USI has provided 306 linkages to community services based on the needs and assessments of families.

PEOPLE FIRST IN ACTION

People First, empowered by Urban Strategies, Inc., just completed its fourth year of service to the residents of the former Tidewater Gardens community. The organization continues its mission of empowering residents in the areas of housing stability, health, education, and job training. Here is an example of what happens when residents and People First work together – success!

WHO: A senior resident with custodial rights of her five grandchildren ages 4, 5, 9, and 14-year-old twins, expressed interest in enrolling the youngest children in school but shared she wasn't exactly sure how to navigate the Parent Vue portal for registration.

WHAT: The People First Education Specialist (ES), offered to set up a time with the resident in the People First Resource lab to assist with activating her account. The first day, the resident and the ES spent

two hours creating the account and uploading all

known



documents. Prior to completion of registration, the system required custody paperwork to be uploaded. Unfortunately, the resident did not have the required paperwork to complete the application. Another date was scheduled to complete the registration process. Two days later, the resident returned to the USI office, in the rain, to upload the custody papers for the children, but unfortunately her account had been locked.

THE WIN: The ES was able to call the NPS preschool office to get assistance and help her log back into the system. All required paperwork was submitted to the online portal and both grandchildren are enrolled for school. Residents, former or current, know they can depend on People FirstUSI to go above and beyond to advocate for them. Now two more former Tidewater Gardens youth will have quality early learning experiences in the 2023-2024 school year.

DEVELOPMENT

EMPOWERING MINORITY & WOMEN OWNED BUSINESSES

The St. Paul's project is not only transformational for residents in Norfolk, but it's also a chance to transform business opportunities, especially for minority and women owned businesses. On July 27, the Norfolk Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) convened the "Minority and Women-owned Business Contract Access Focus Group" at the Richard A. Tucker Memorial Library.



Focusing on the St. Paul's Transformation Project, this exclusive gathering of 13 construction vendors and subject matter experts explored avenues to enhance economic inclusion in city projects. Key discussions centered on opportunity access and RFP responses, challenges and support. Constructive feedback and suggestions were received, with ideas ranging from mentorship programs and banking assistance, to vendor partnerships and more. The session was a platform for dialogue and a space for collaboration. DHCD staff are reviewing all suggestions, and we thank the vendors for their time and expertise.

UNITY PLACE

Building permits have been secured and construction starts in September for the next new buildings in St. Paul's. It's called Unity Place at Kindred – the newest apartment homes located at 600 East Freemason Street and 466 St. Paul's Blvd. The official groundbreaking ceremony is Wednesday, September 13th from 1-3PM.
